- IELTS score of 6.5 or its equivalent in another recognized English proficiency test.
- Successfully deliver a presentation on one of the given topics.

The final assessment score will be based on the presentation performance, following the evaluation rubric provided.

Presentation

Objective:

You will deliver a presentation on one of given topics, which aims to evaluate research, critical thinking, and communication skills. The presentation should be informative, well-structured, and professionally delivered.

Presentation Topics:

You may choose one of the following topics for your presentation:

1. The importance of learning English in today's world.
2. How AI is transforming language learning.
3. Effective strategies for mastering a new language.
4. Why TEFL (Teaching English as a Foreign Language) is a great career choice.
5. How to stay motivated while learning a language.
6. The role of AI in education.
7. My journey to becoming a successful English learner.
8. Learning multiple languages: advantages and challenges.
9. The pros and cons of language learning apps.
10. Common mistakes language learners make and how to avoid them.
11. How traveling enhances language learning.
12. Why some languages are more difficult to learn than others.

Requirements:

1. Presentation Duration:

- Maximum 12 minutes for the presentation.
- 5 minutes for the Q&A session.

2. Content Structure:

Each presentation should include the following components:

a) Introduction:

- Introduce the topic and explain why it is important.

b) Main Discussion:

- Present key ideas, research findings, and real-life examples.

- Discuss challenges, solutions, and personal insights (if applicable).
- Provide a structured and logical flow of information.

c) Conclusion:

- Summarize key takeaways.
- Offer a final thought or call to action.

3. Visual Aids:

- Use slides, charts, or other visuals to enhance understanding.
- Ensure visuals are clear, concise, and relevant to the topic.

4. Language & Delivery:

- The presentation must be in clear, professional English.
- Maintain proper pronunciation, tone, and confidence.
- Engage the audience with eye contact and effective body language.

Assessment Criteria

1. Content Quality

- Relevance and depth of analysis of the chosen topic
- Logical organization of ideas and clear structure
- Use of credible sources and supporting evidence
- Originality and critical thinking in presenting insights and perspectives
- Clarity and effectiveness of the conclusion in summarizing key points

2. Presentation Skills

- Clarity and coherence of the presentation
- Effective use of visual aids to enhance understanding
- Confidence, professionalism, and engagement with the audience
- Effective pacing and time management
- Use of body language and eye contact to maintain audience interest

3. Language Proficiency

- Correct use of grammar and vocabulary
- Fluency and natural flow of speech
- Pronunciation and clarity of speech

4. Q&A Session

- Ability to answer questions accurately and confidently
- Depth of knowledge demonstrated in responses
- Engagement with the audience and ability to think on the spot
